The certification.

UL1076: Standard for Safety Proprietary Burglar Alarm Units and Systems for the United States of America.

The meaning and benefit.

ICT's Protege WX and Protege GX controllers meet industry established standards for what equipment is used, how it's installed, and how it performs when used to protect against intruders. Any deliberate tampering with the alarm systems circuitry automatically trigger's an alarm signal to the central monitoring station.

This standard typically applies to indoor use. The protected properties may be a single premises or multiple, separate properties under a single owner.

Any alarm activity picked up by the controllers will be sent to the monitoring station, who can alert the proper authorities, as well as your Protege WX or Protege GX system, so you can see what's happening, as it's happening.

This certificate works in conjunction with UL294 - Standard for Access Control System Units for a fully unified access control and intrusion detection solution. This allows both arms of the security system to be monitored by one monitoring station. No mix-ups or confusion between disparate systems and monitoring stations, giving you peace of mind that nothing will be missed.
